

Player's Guide: The Mod Library

What is the Mod Library?

In simple terms, the Mod Library is your central hub for installing, viewing, and managing all of your downloaded mods. It's designed to make the entire process easy and safe, so you can spend less time managing files.

Imagine the usual struggles of installing mods manually:

1. You download a mod, usually in a .zip or .7z file.
2. You have to find your game's ~mods folder, which can be in a confusing location (.../Paks/~mods/LogicMods).
3. You have to correctly extract the files from the archive into that folder. Sometimes they're nested in extra subfolders that break the mod.
4. If you want to disable a mod, you have to manually rename files (like adding -x) or delete them, hoping you don't break anything.
5. If you want to update a mod, you have to remember to delete the old files first before copying the new ones.
6. There's no easy way to see which mods are active or organize them.

The Mod Library in TMM8 solves all these problems.

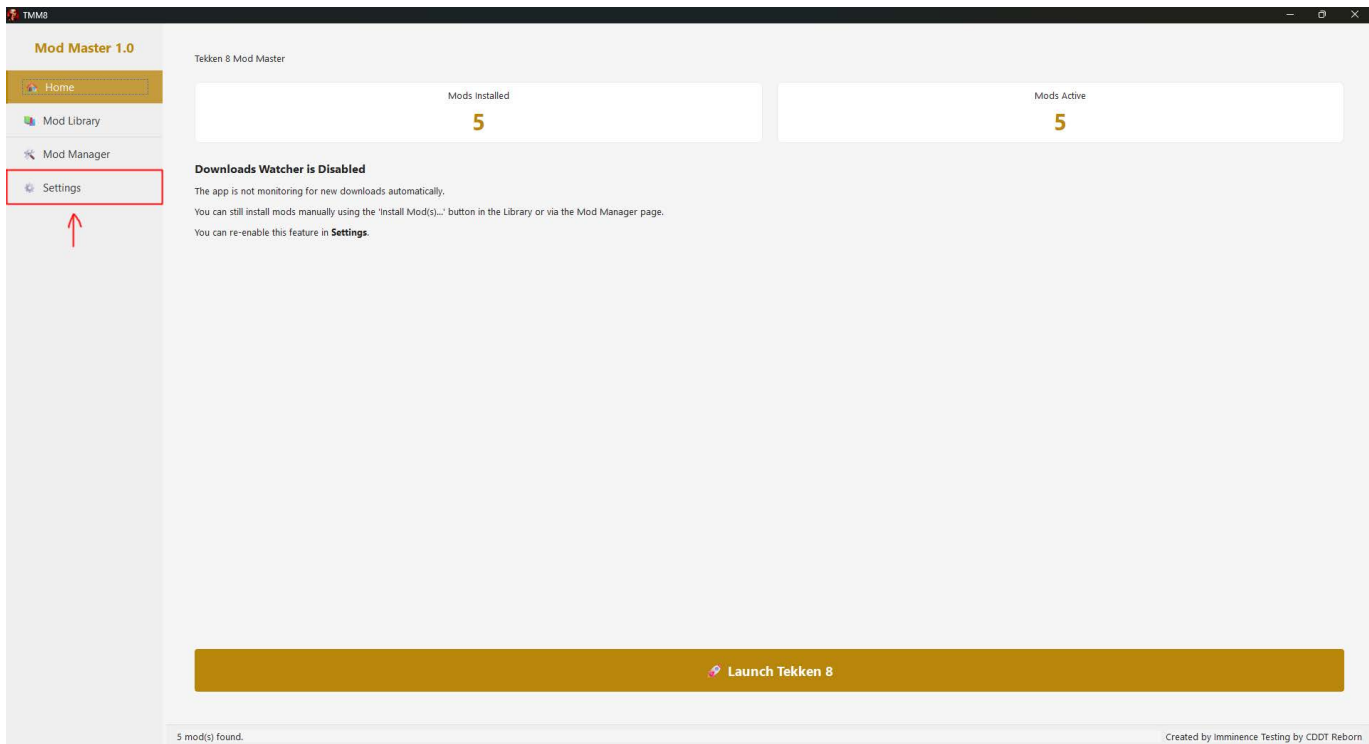
How to Use the Mod Library (First-Time Setup)

Before you can install mods, you need to tell the app two important things. You only need to do this once.

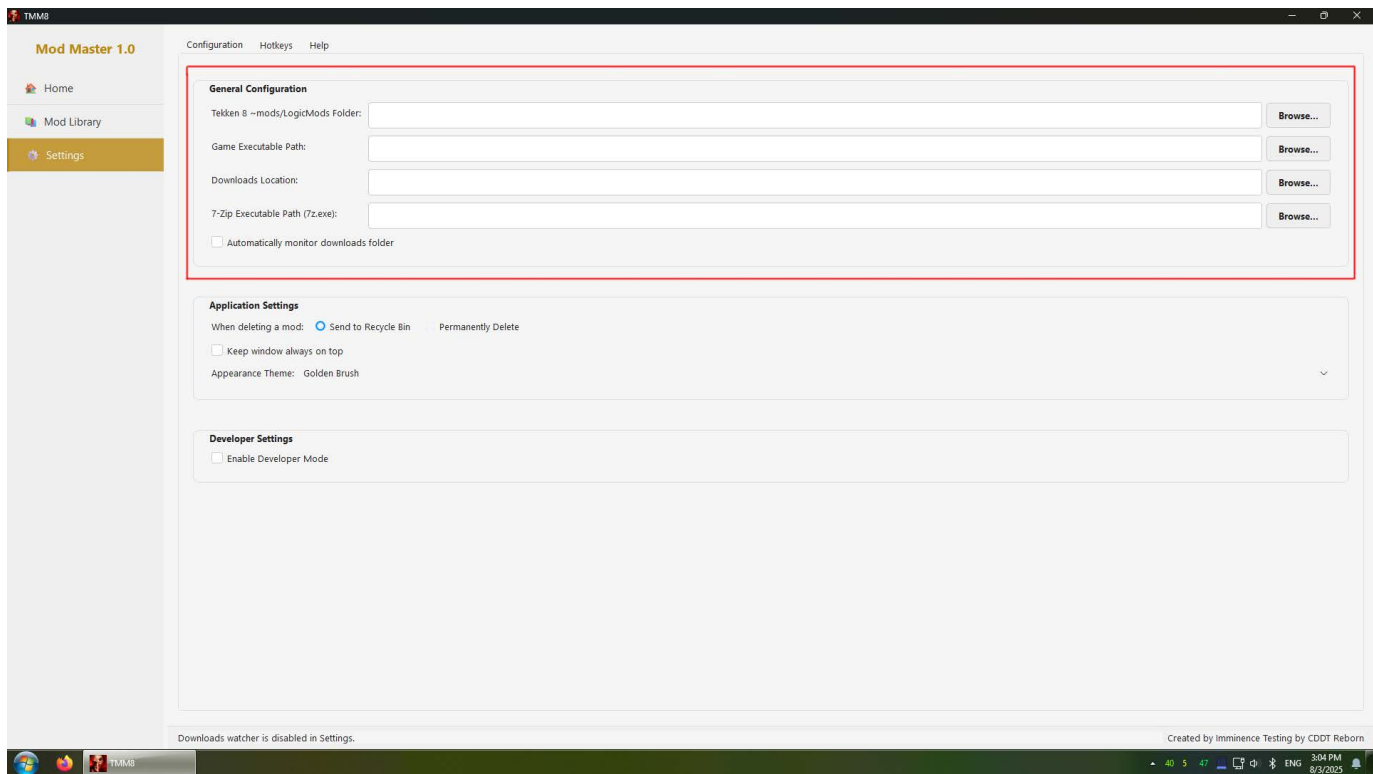
1. Go to the Settings page.

Set the Essential Paths:

Once you go to the settings page , You'll see tap called "General Configuration"

1. lets set the Mods Path So they will show up in the Mods library .

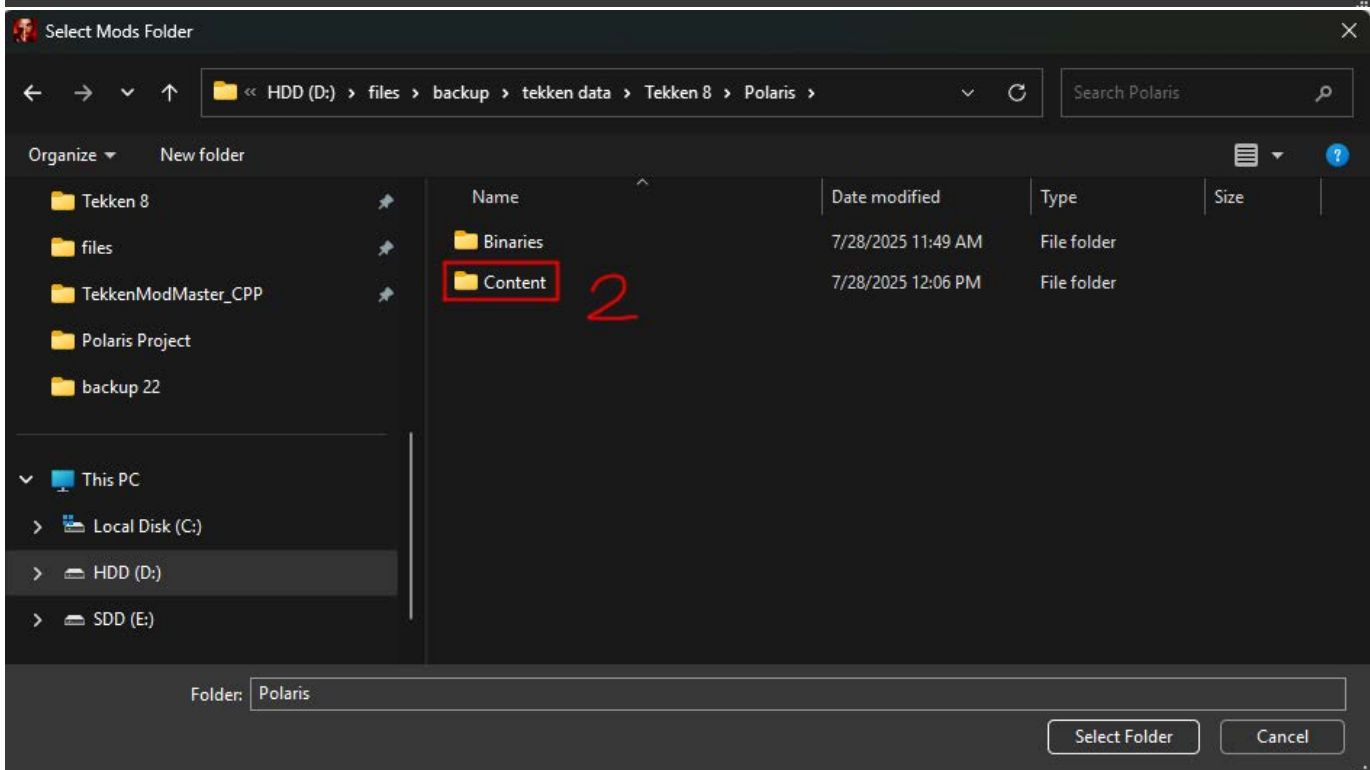
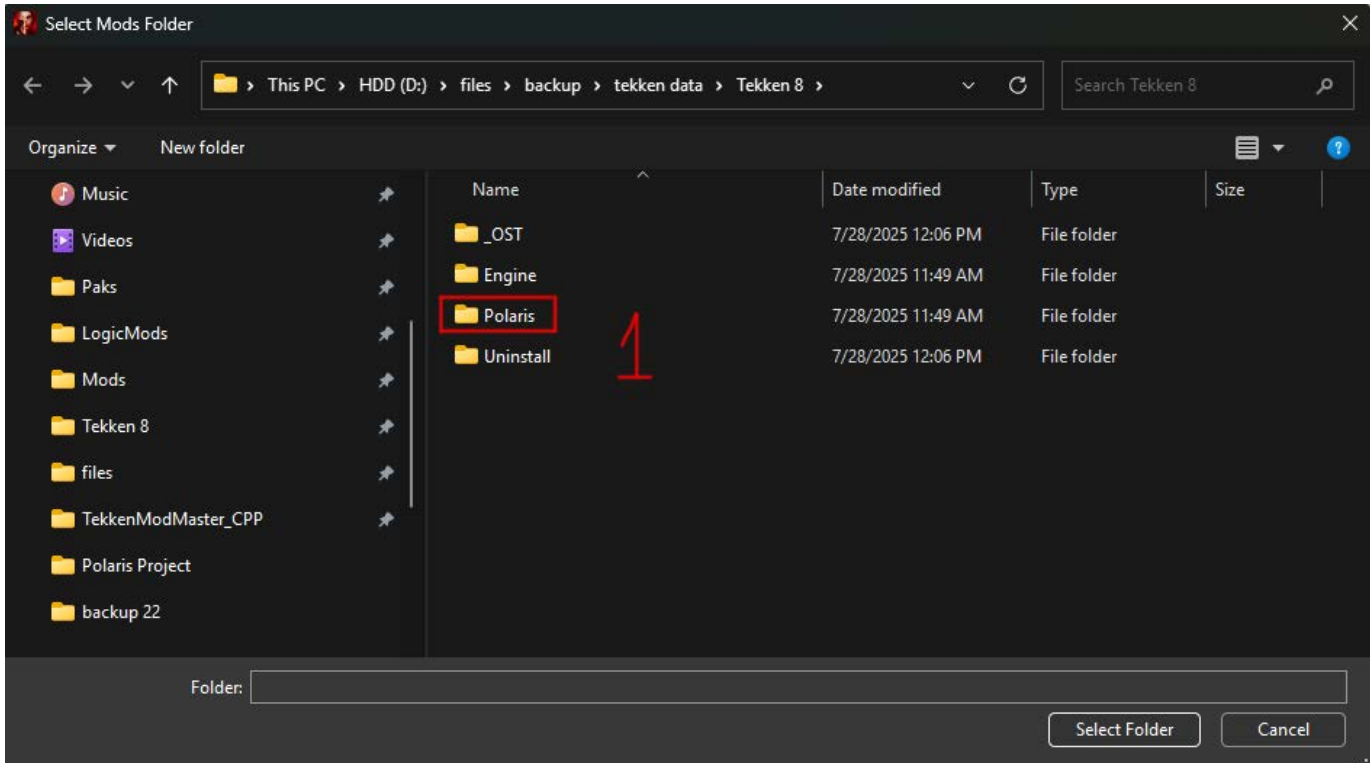

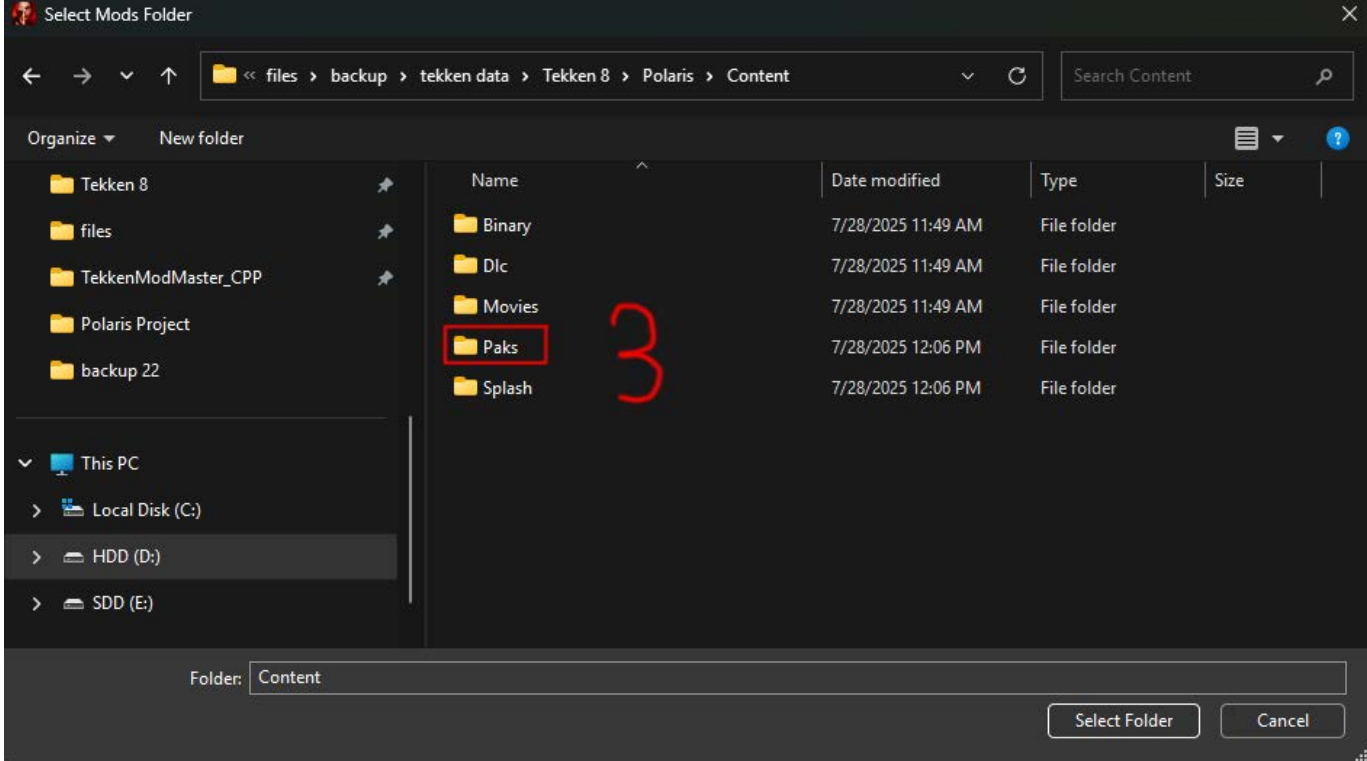

2. Go to where you installed the Game, for example: C:\Program Files (x86)\Steam\steamapps\common\Tekken 8

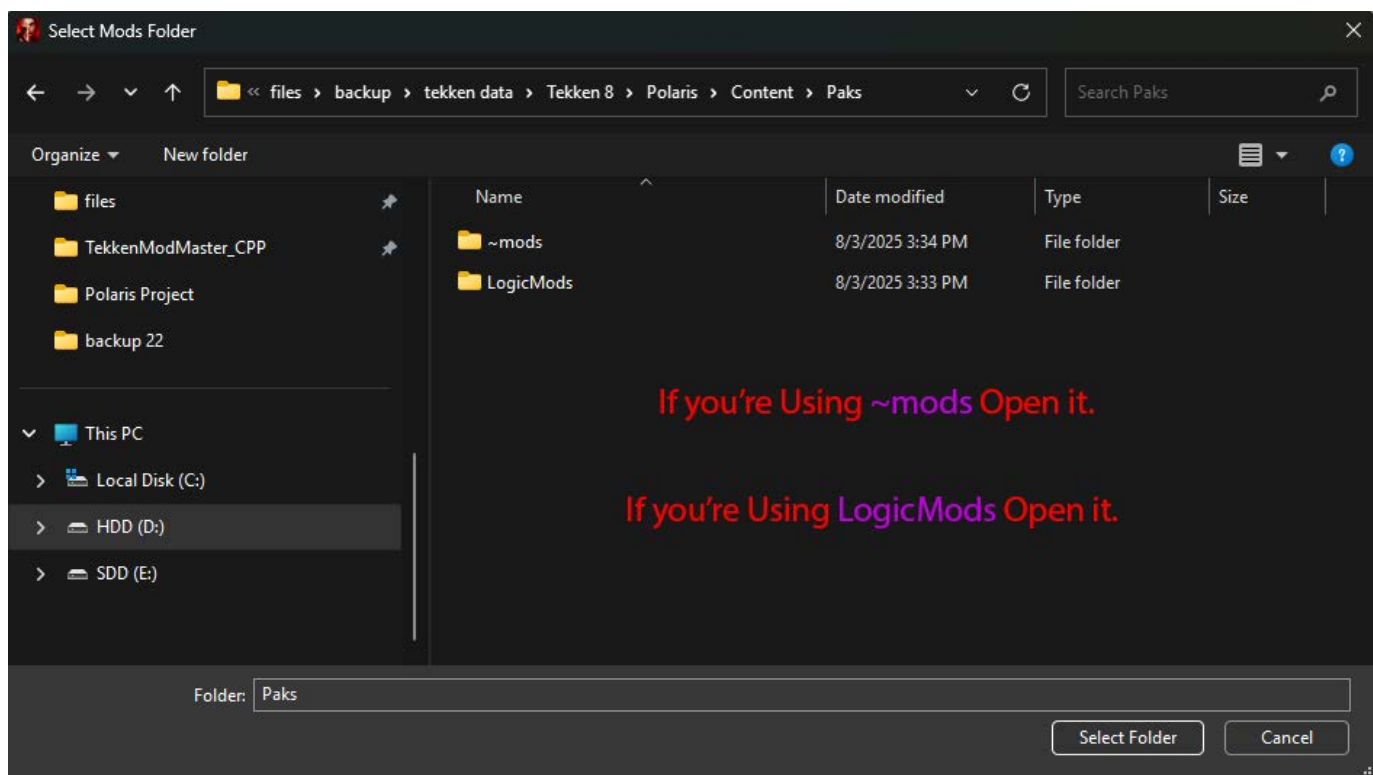




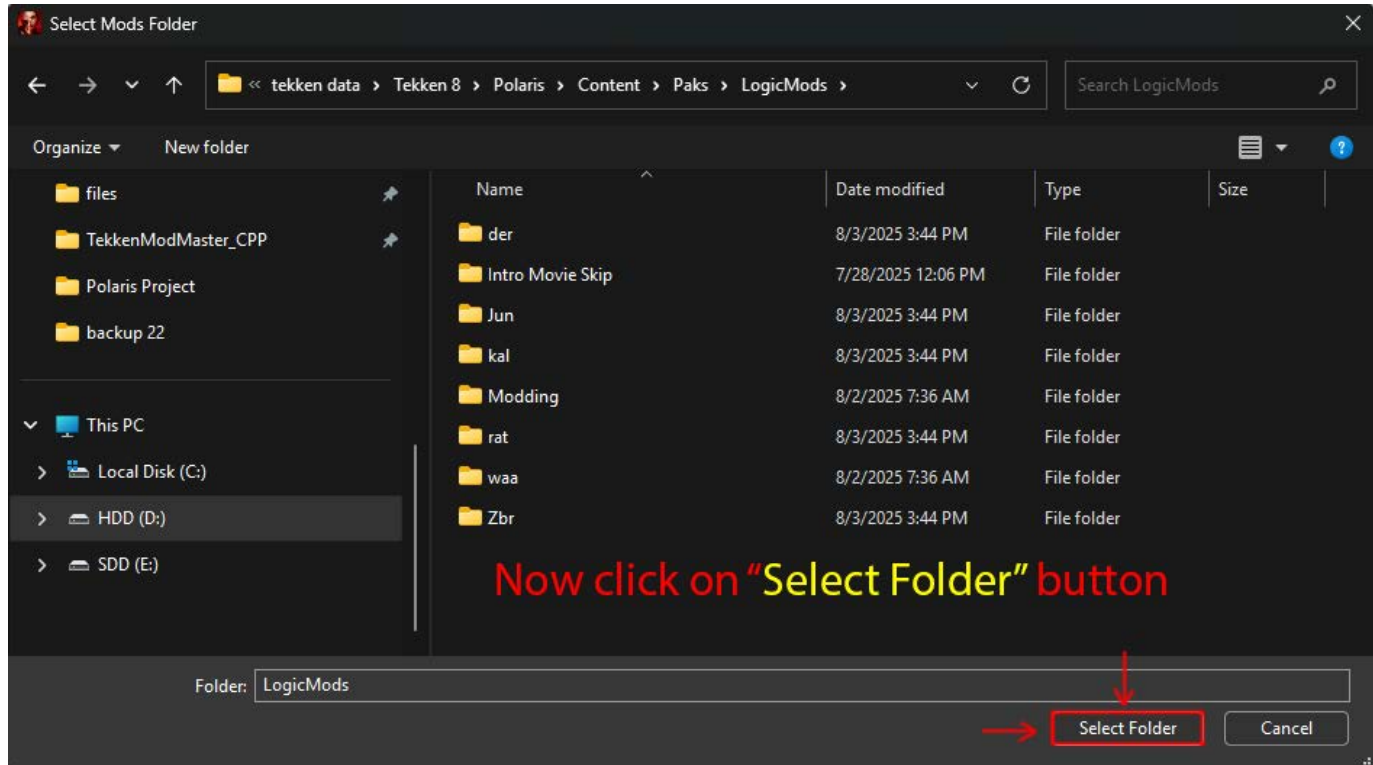

Its very easy to do.

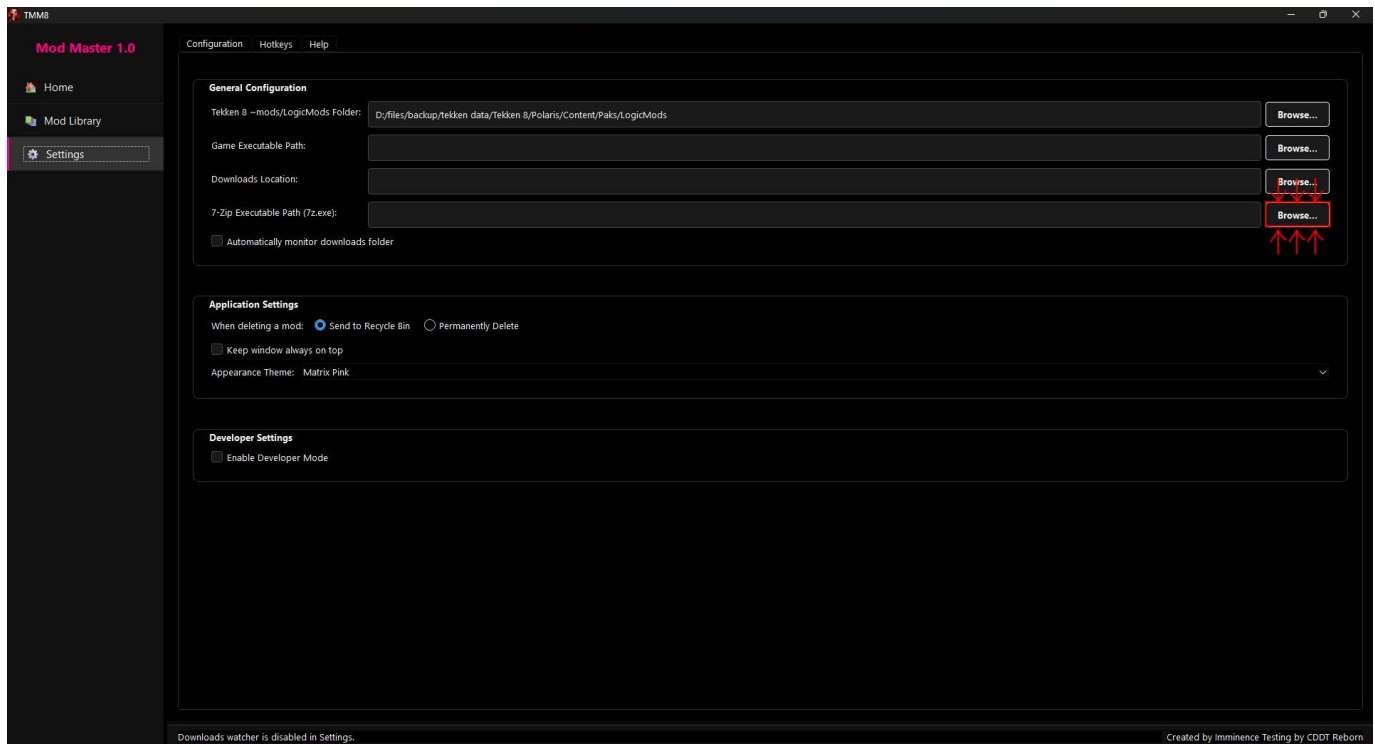
STEP 1

1. Download it form Their official Website. <https://www.7-zip.org/>

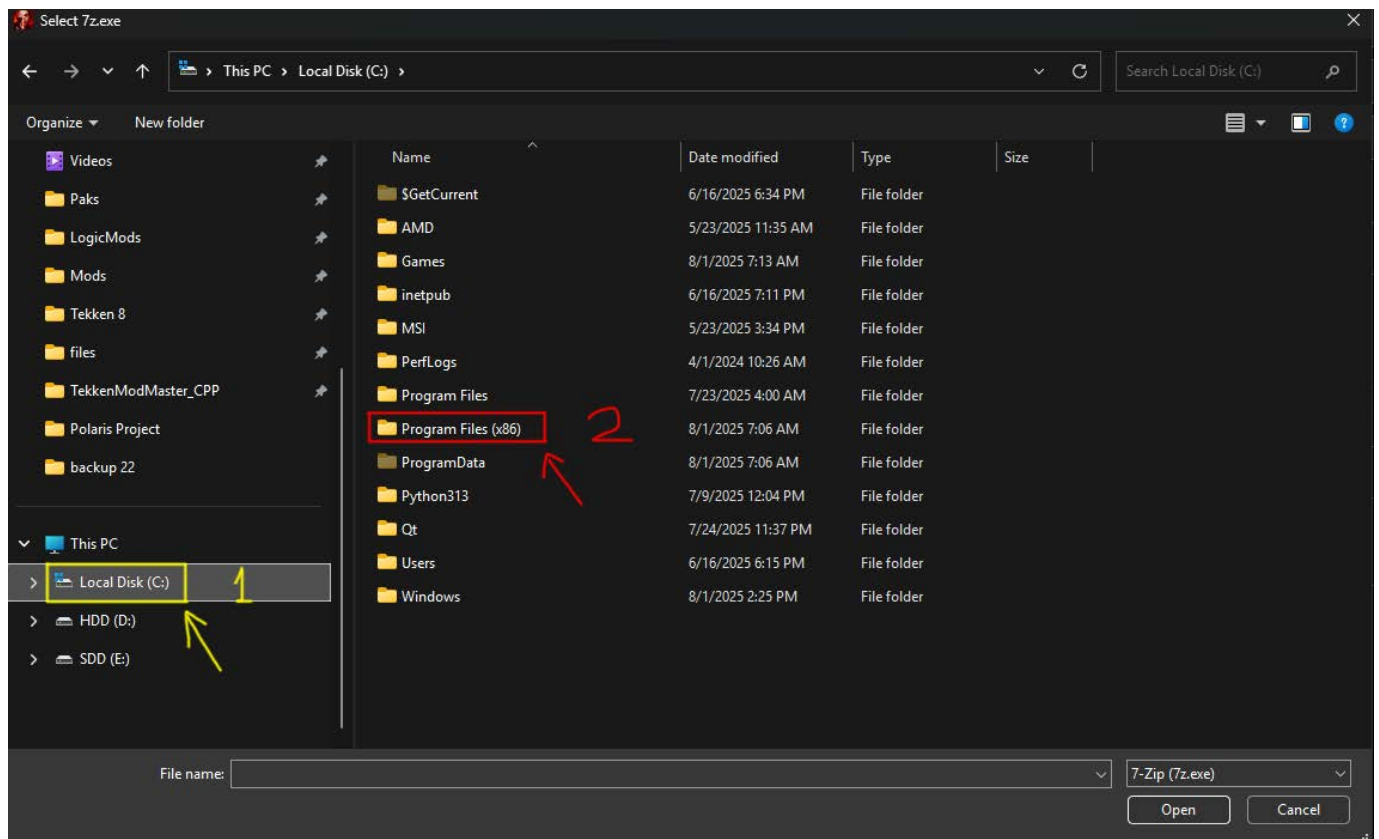
(You dont have to download it if you already have it).

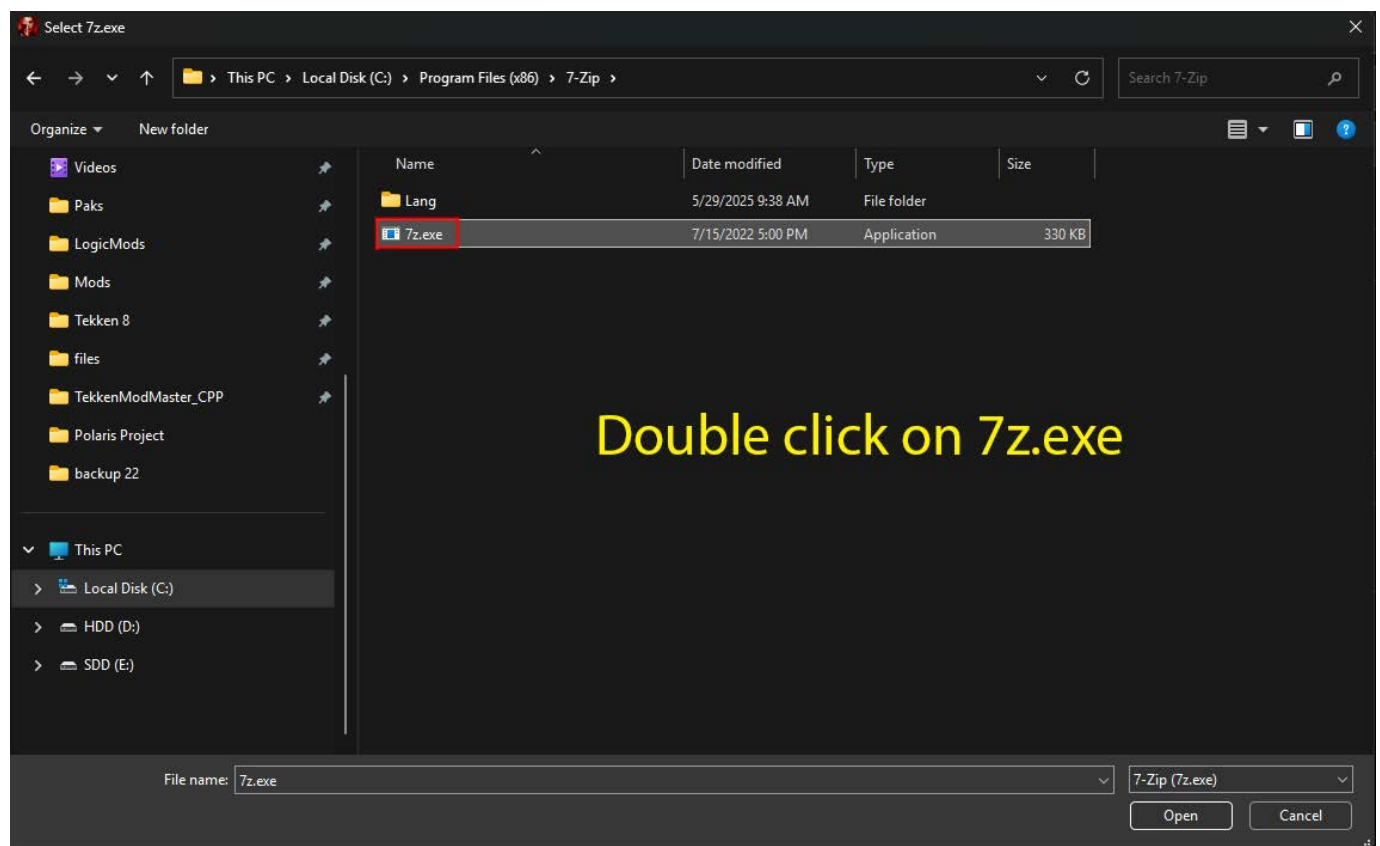
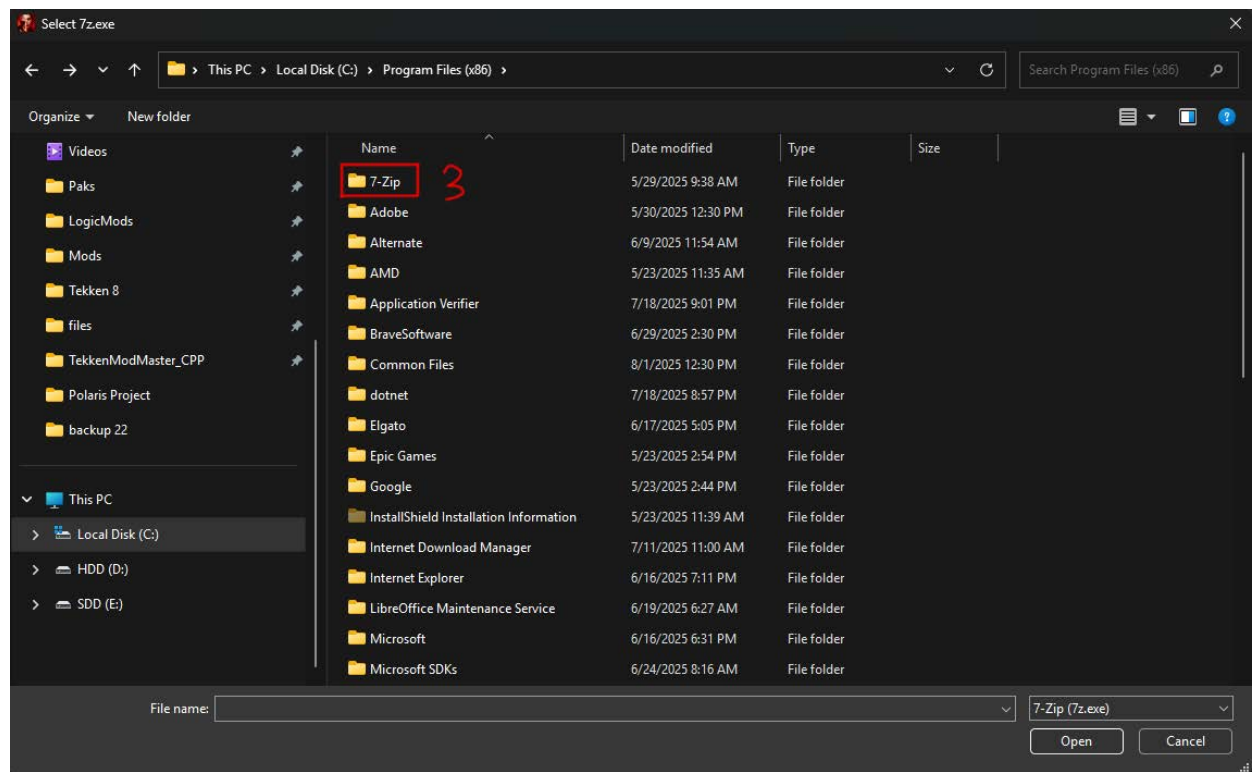
2. Go to the settings Page.

1. Open where you installed Tekken 8.

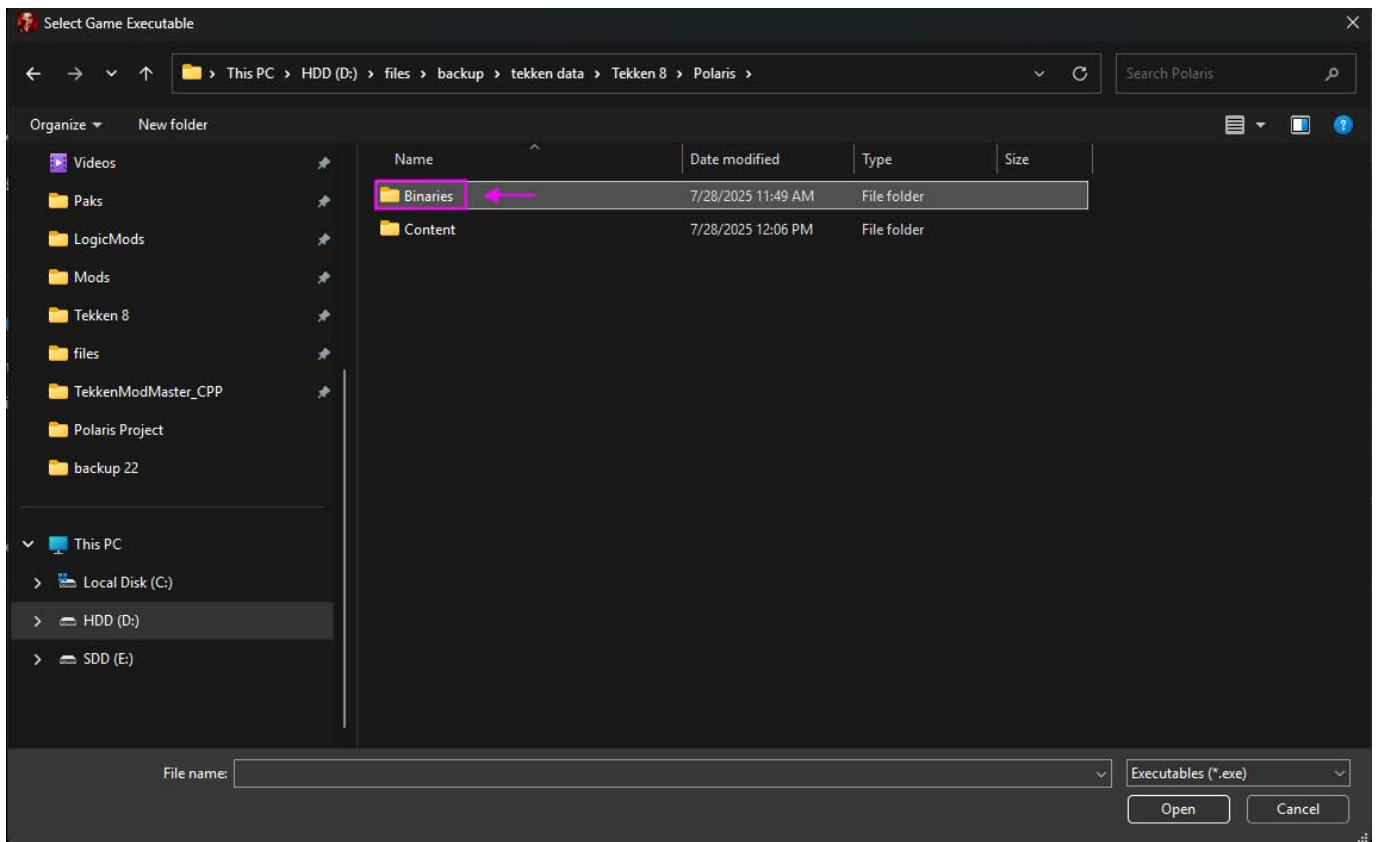
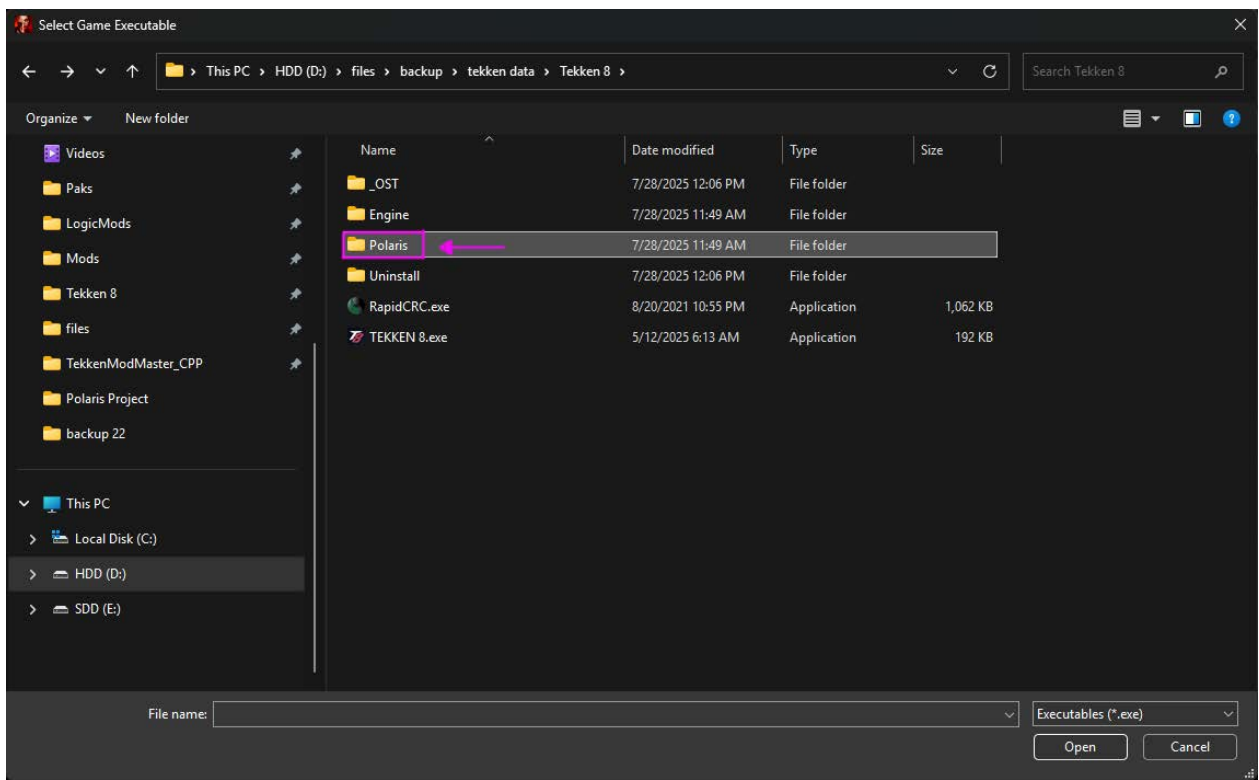

What is "Download watcher"?

If you open this tool, and go to **TekkenMods** website and download a Mod, the tool will ask you after the mod has finished downloading if you want to install it.

Example:



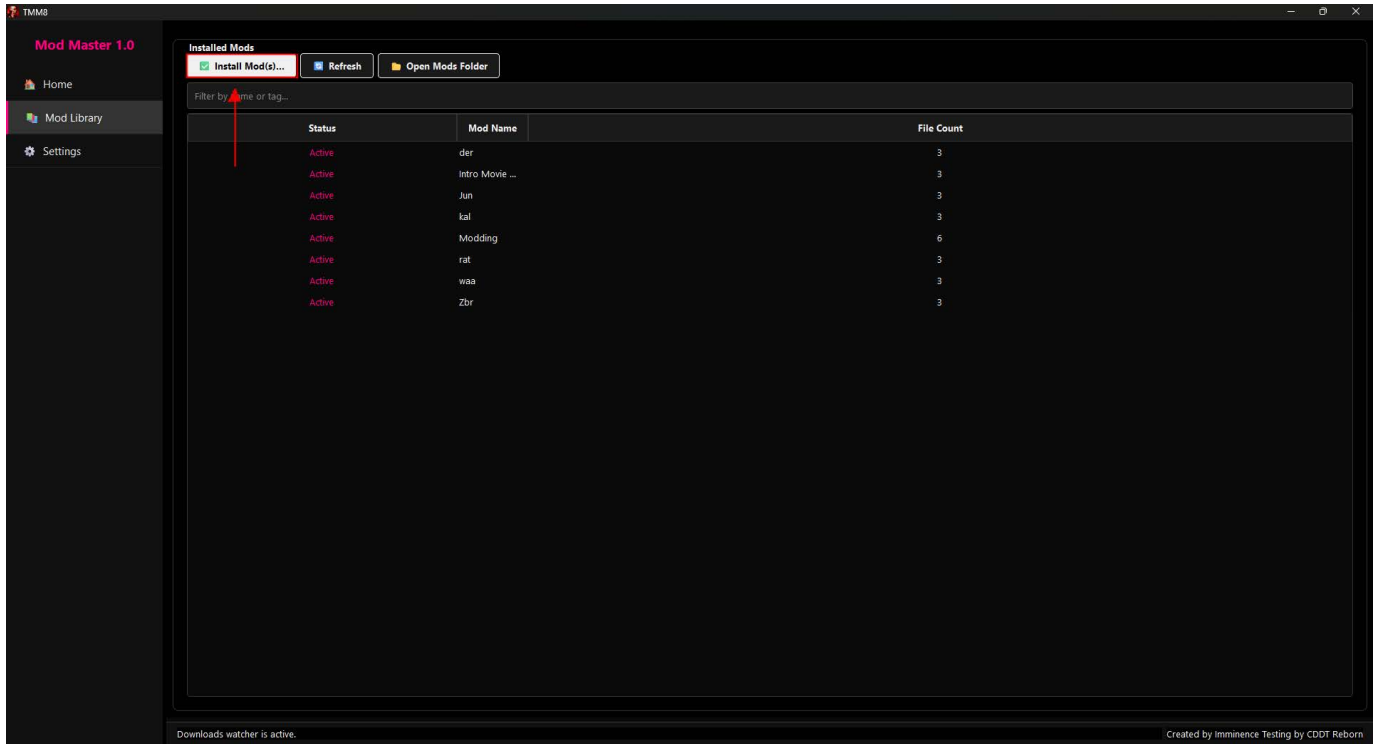
Double click on your Folder and then click **"Select Folder"** button

How to Install a Mod

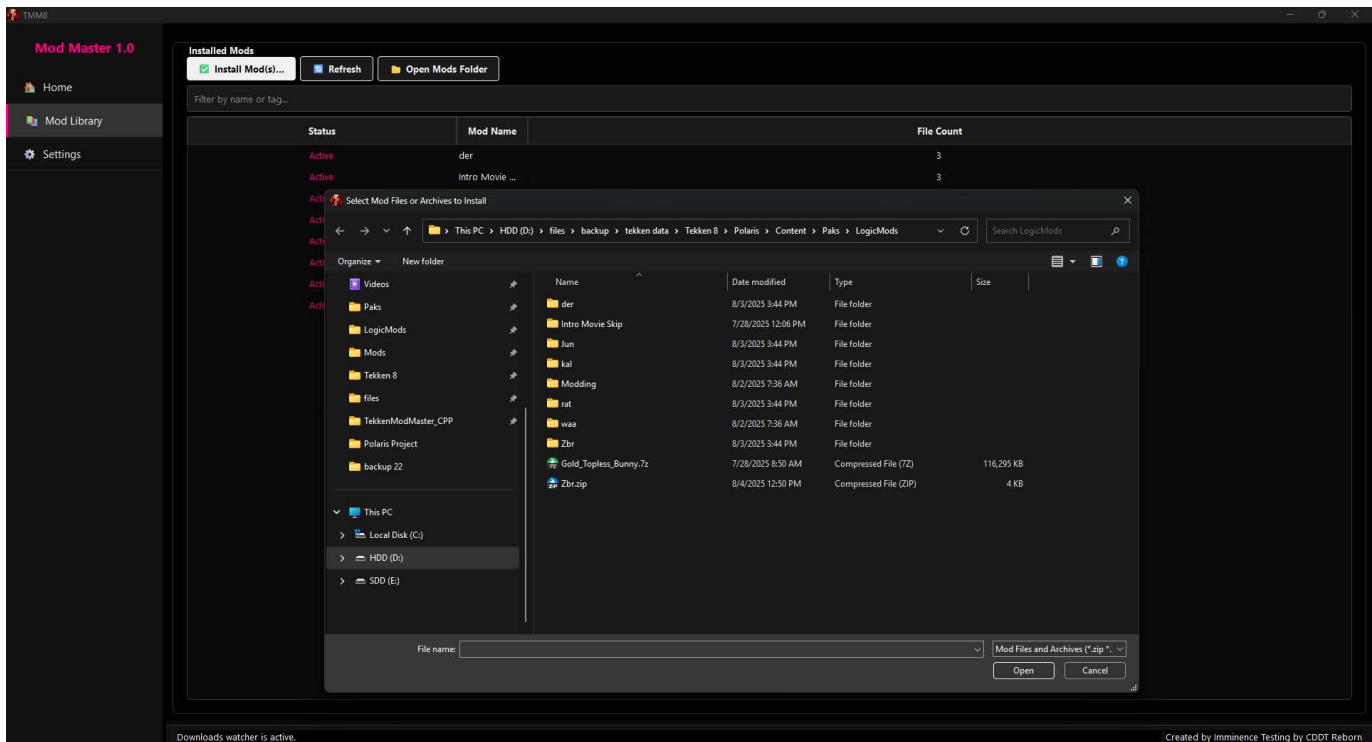
There are two easy ways to install a mod using the Mod Library.

1. In the Mod Library, click the "Install Mod(s)..." button.

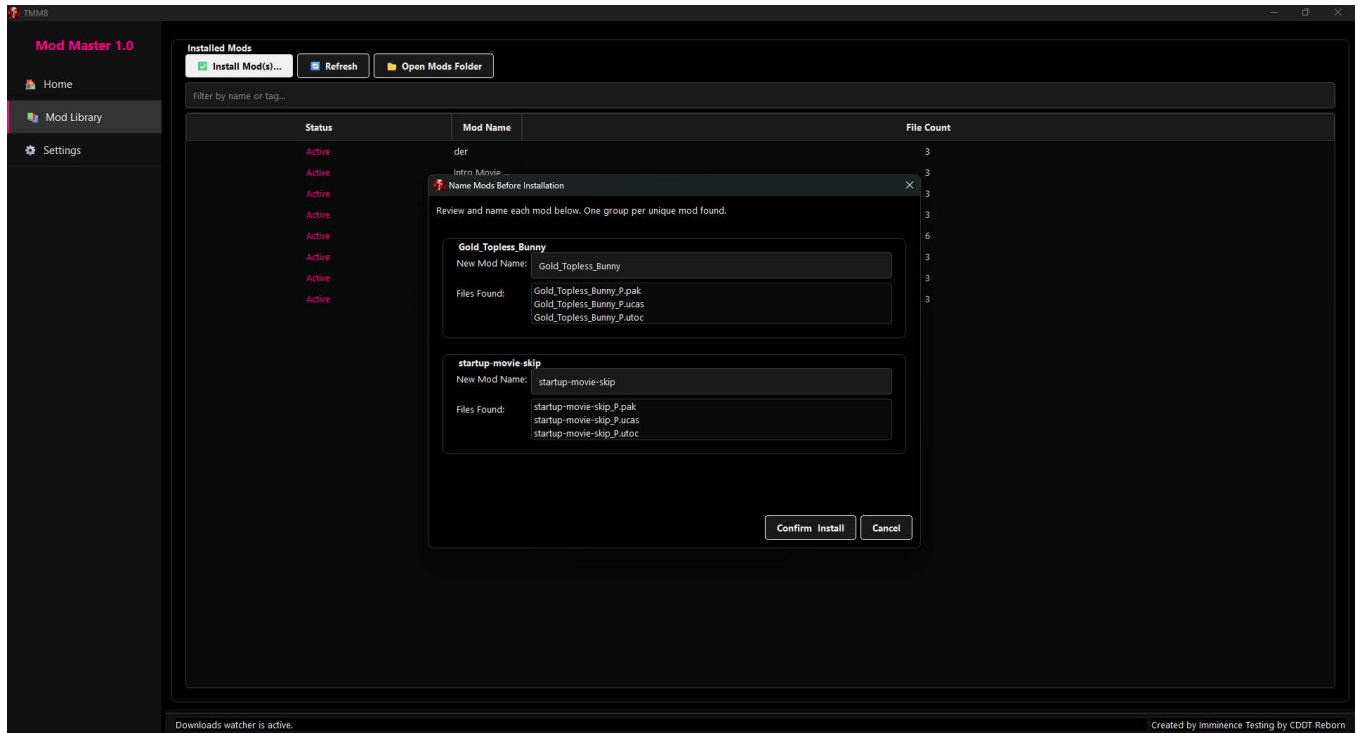


2. A file dialog will open. Navigate to where you keep your downloaded Mods, Tekken Mods are (.zip, .rar, .7z , .pak).

You can select More than one Mod to install.



3. A new window will appear, allowing you to give the mod a clean name before it's installed. This name will be used for its folder, keeping your mods organized. Type a name and click "Confirm & Install".



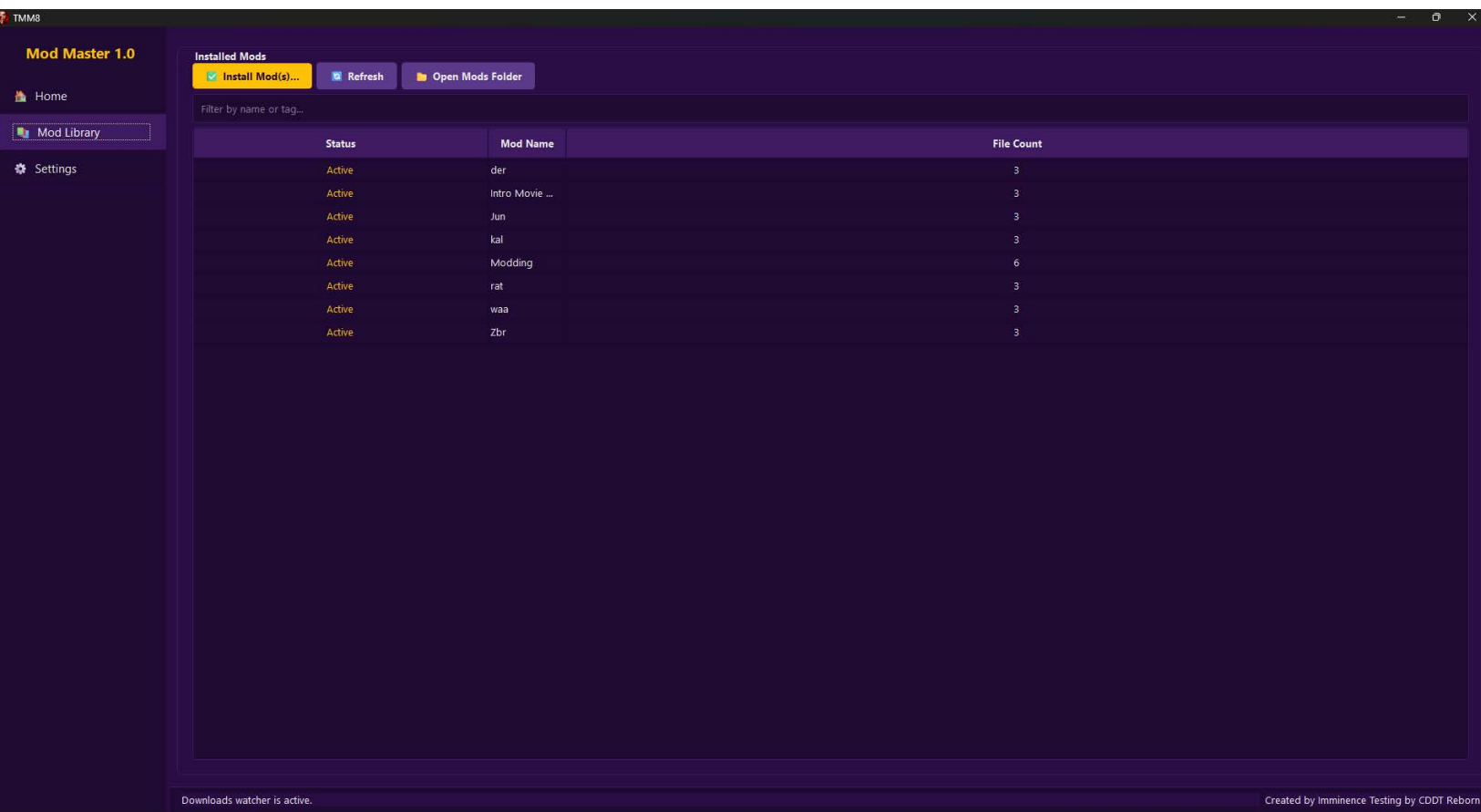
Method 2: Drag and Drop

Simply drag the mod from your computer and drop them anywhere on the Mod Master window. The same naming window will appear, and your mod will be installed!

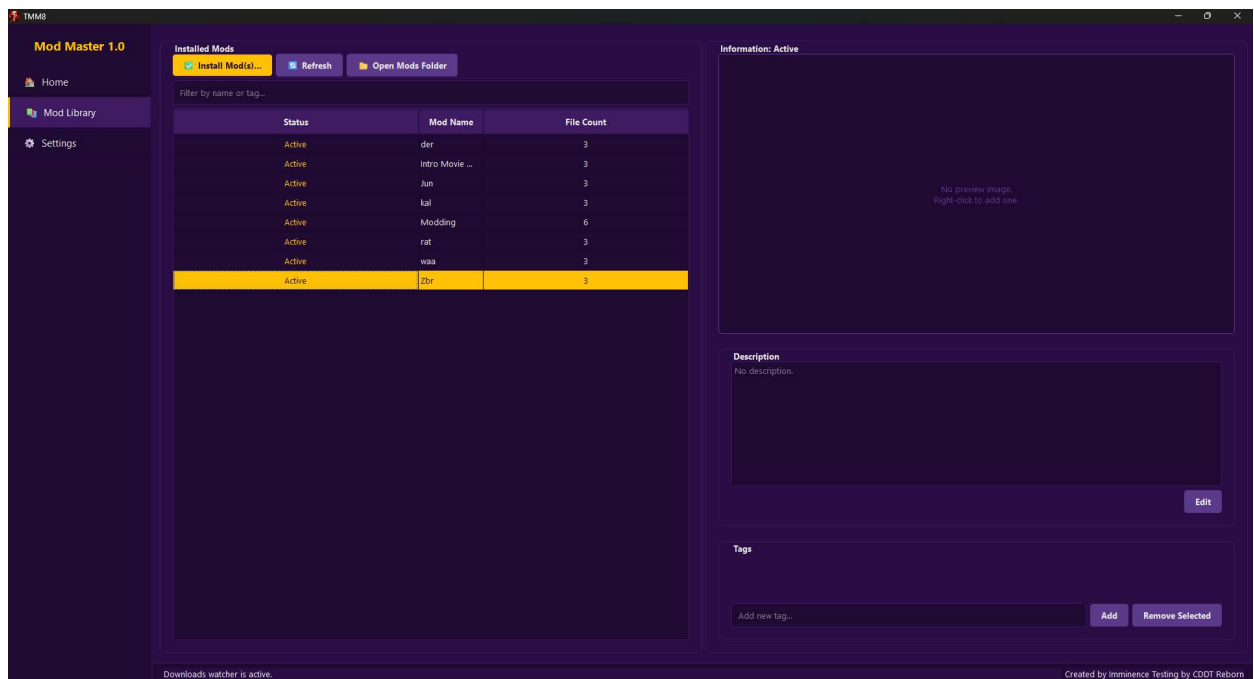
Supported Files through Drag and Drop:

- **.rar**
- **.zip**
- **.7z**
- **.pak**
- **.ucas**
- **.utoc**

Breaking Down the Interface



- The Main List (Left): This shows every mod you currently have installed in your ~mods/LogicMods folder. You can quickly see its Status (Active/Disabled), its Name, and how many Files it contains. You can click on the column headers to sort the list.



- The Details Panel (Right): When you select a mod from the list, this panel shows you more information about it. Initially, it will be empty, but you can add your own details to keep everything organized.

- The Filter Bar (Top): Can't find a mod? Just start typing its name or one of its tags in the filter bar to instantly narrow down the list.

Managing Your Mods

Once mods are installed, managing them is simple.

- **Enable / Disable:**

- Select one or more mods in the list.
- Right-click and choose **Enable** or **Disable**.
- Disabling a mod safely renames its files so the game ignores it, but you don't have to delete it. This is perfect for temporarily turning mods off.

- **Delete a Mod:**

- Select the mod(s) you want to remove.
- Right-click and choose "Delete Selected" or press the Del key.
- The mod files will be safely removed.

- **Adding Your Own Details (Metadata):**

1. Select a mod.
2. In the panel on the right, you can add a Preview Image, a Description, and Tags.
3. To add a preview, right-click the mod in the main list and choose "Set Preview Image..."
4. To edit the description, just click the "Edit" button in the details panel.
5. To add tags, type a tag name in the input box and click "Add". Tags are great for filtering (e.g., "Costume", "Character", "UI").
